

Index for Journal of Trinidad and Tobago Field Naturalists' Club 1956 - 1989

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From 1965 the journal has been published biennially. In 1977 for the first time the title carried both years of the two year span thus: Journal of The Trinidad and Tobago Field Naturalists' Club 1977 - 1978. However, the 1979 -1980 issue was wrongly titled 1978 - 1979 so there is no issue titled 1979 - 1980. In the index the dates given refer to the first of the two years in the title even though the actual dates of publication may have slipped into the second year.

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
